Required Non-Certificate Prerequisite Courses:

Certificate Eligibility: Students are eligible for the PBAC if they:

- a) earned a baccalaureate degree in an area other than accounting; or
b) received an accounting degree outside the United States; or
c) graduated with less than the 225 quarter credit hours required to sit for the Oregon CPA exam AND need a minimum of 12 credits listed under "Required Certificate Courses."

To be eligible to enter the program, students must:

- 1. Have earned a baccalaureate degree recognized by the EOU Registrar.
2. Be formally admitted to EOU as a post-baccalaureate undergraduate student.
3. Complete or have completed the prerequisite courses that are not part of the certificate.
