  discussion. EPCC had further discussion and determined that the next step would be for the math faculty to
  have a meeting with the Provost.
- 8. EPCC Committee Structure Jeff Dense handed out a summary of his evaluation for committee composition at the other OUS schools. He recommends we consider a vice-chair model to allow for consistency and ease of transition when new Chairs are appointed.
- 9. On-site (weekend college) credits Regina shared the need to create a policy for on-site courses and specifically the amount of seat time required. The current standard for the courses is 2 credits but some courses were grandfathered in at 3 credits. In the policy it would be important to describe the use of blackboard, number of contact hours, etc.
