  - (created when you logged into your EOU email for the first time).

  - Select Residence Life link
  - Submit your housing deposit
  - Follow the instructions and click **My Housing** to complete your application.
- International Students are permitted to move into the residence halls Friday or Saturday prior to International Student Orientation beginning on Sunday at dinner. #### PACK YOUR BAGS!

La Grande is located approximately four hours from Portland, Oregon, five hours from Seattle, Washington, and three hours from Boise, Idaho. Many students fly into Portland (**flypdx.com/PDX**), Boise (**iflyboise.com**) or Seattle (**portseattle.org/Sea-Tac/Pages/default.aspx**), and then take another plane to the regional airport in Pendleton, Oregon. It is approximately one hour away from La Grande. Boutique Air services the Pendleton Airport (**boutiqueair.com**).

Another option is to take the Greyhound bus to La Grande (**greyhound.com**). The International Student Advisor can meet you at the bus station in La Grande and drive you to campus or you can take the Shuttle to campus. *Please note that the bus ride is long with many stops.* 

- □ If you need picked up at the La Grande Greyhound Bus Station or airport, complete the Arrival Notification Form (**eou.edu/intprog/pre-arrival**) prior to arriving. *Students are charged an airport pick up fee.*
